St Mark's Occupational Health & Safety Policy

- Students are asked to think about their own actions while participating in St Mark's training so as not to endanger their own safety and/or the safety of others.
- Students who do not pay attention to instructions concerning safety will be asked to leave a course and, in such cases, refunds will not be given.
- Students should immediately contact the trainer and the Director of St Mark's if they have any concerns about course safety.
- St Mark's has a policy of no smoking in any workplace, training facility or motor vehicle owned or being used by St Mark's in its operations.
- St Mark's has a policy that prohibits the use of drugs or alcohol during work or training in any workplace, training facility or motor vehicle owned or being used by St Mark's during its operations.
- All incidents or accidents will be recorded in writing and reported to the Director of St Mark's.
